

Women IN THE CHURCH

Under the leadership of Miss Margaret Barnes, American missionary, the North China Christian Rural Service Union is attempting to tackle some of the root causes of poverty and distress in this vast populated area. Some of the very practical projects which Miss Barnes and her Chinese men and women associates are working on are: rural church development, crop improvement, well digging for irrigation, promoting cooperatives, loan libraries, vocational training, family life education. The activities under these headings run from erecting poultry houses, and planting grape vines to classes in adult literacy and the betterment of parents-child relationships.

It is estimated that there are some 700,000 men, women and children refugees from Palestine in Syria and Lebanon. . . . Recently the women of the Presbyterian U.S.A. Mission in Syria-Lebanon distributed among the refugees clothing that has been given through Church World Service, and turned over the use of property as temporary housing. Nine teachers, all refugees, were employed in an educational project among Palestinian children in Sidon; and classes for boys and girls—sewing instruction, literacy classes, etc.—were established. In other relief projects for the refugees the Presbyterians cooperated with the Arab Protestant Church.

"Progress in the long road to peace depends in large measure on the growing number of women who in their own communities and nation are bringing an enlightened public opinion; this in the last analysis, is the only sound basis for international understanding and on which depends the effectiveness of the

statements of the world," says Miss Ruth Woodsmall, Y. W. C. A. leader. "Statesmen cannot work in a vacuum. The persistent work and steadfast prayers of the great majority of churchwomen are an inestimable source of strength in world affairs. It is this body of women joined invisibly around the world that carry the real burden of preparing for peace."

Crewman Is Sucked Through Plane Door

Seattle.—An air transport crewman who went to check on a draft around the plane's door was sucked out to an almost certain death over Alaska waters Tuesday night.

The victim was Dave Huycke of Los Angeles, third pilot aboard a Sourdough Air Transport Company C-47.

Fred Whitmire, the firm's Seattle manager, said he was advised by the pilot that the accident occurred four minutes after the takeoff from Annette Island, near Ketchikan with 10 passengers. The flight had originated in Seattle. Anchorage was its destination. Whitmire said the plane's altitude probably was around 3,500 feet.
