Family night means a bargain in admissions. A man and wife and children, regardless of the number unless they are adults, will be admitted for the special family night ticket costing only one dollar.

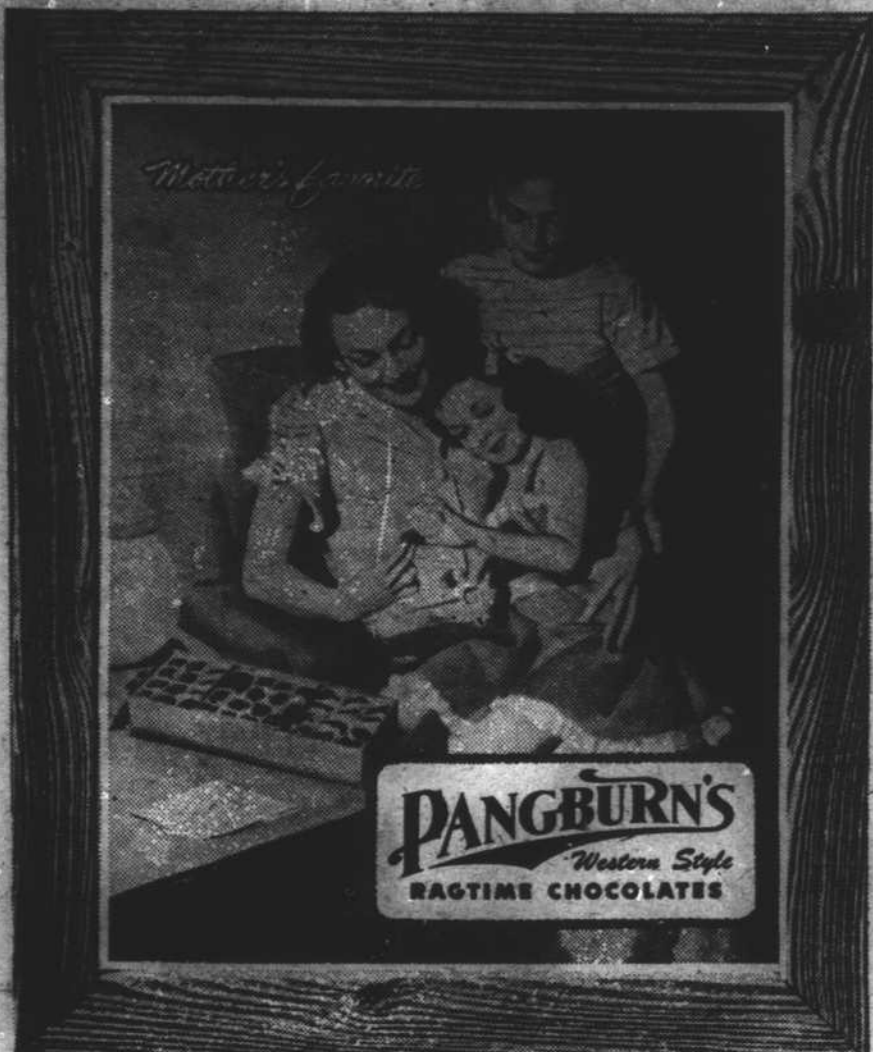
