Mr. and Mrs. Morgan Roope and daughter, Morguena, have returned from two weeks vacation at Palmetta, Florida.


Miss Virginia Hix Brame, is still a patient at the Baptist Hospital in Winston-Salem. Her condition is reported to be slowly improving.


