Services are held at Oak Forest the third Sunday by the new pastor, the Rev. Mr. Day.

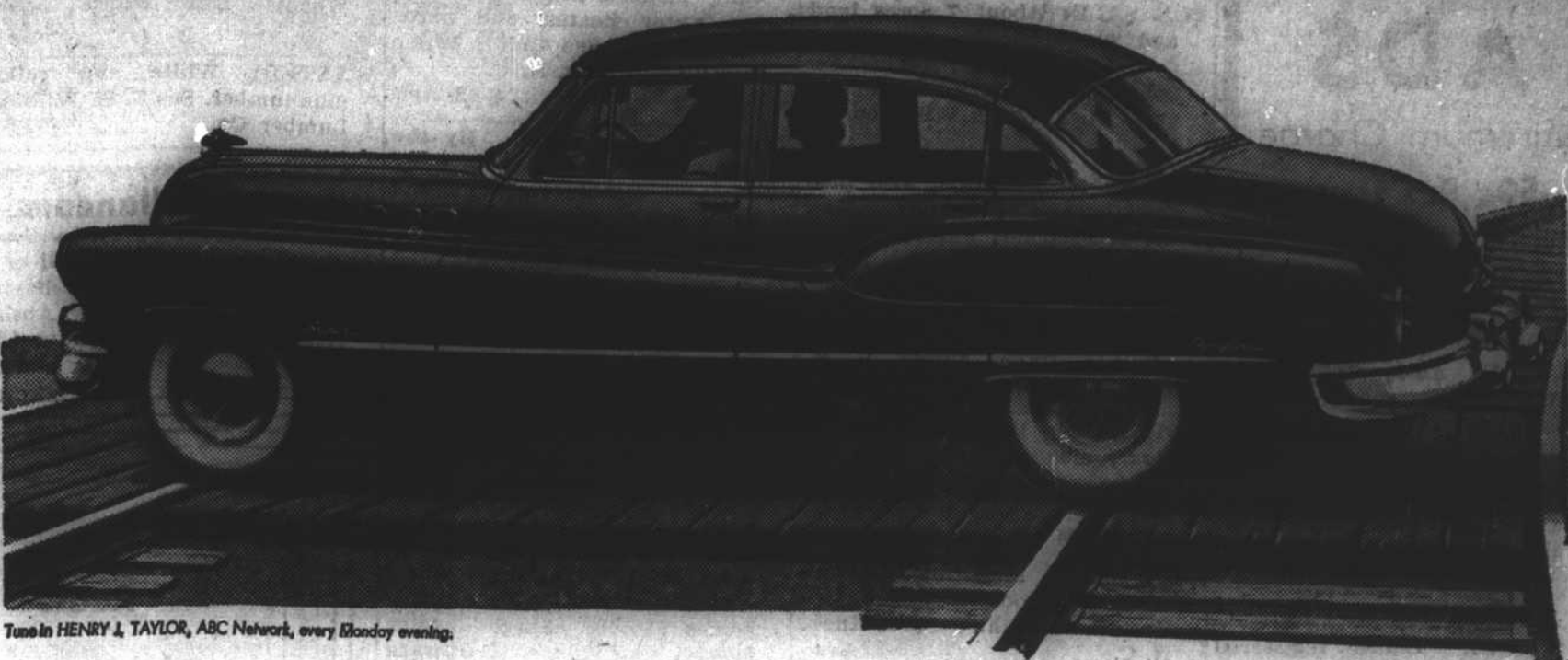
As planned last autumn, Antioch church is being remodeled and Sunday School rooms added.
