THE FAITH OF THE QUAKERS.

The following Quaker declaration of faith was written by George Fox in 1671, and sent to the Governor of Barbadoes: DECLARATION OF FAITH.

Egg Nog.—Six eggs, one pint of milk, half a pound of loaf sugar, half a pint of brandy.

Poached Eggs.—Have a broad shallow vessel of boiling water. Break your eggs in a plate, and be careful not to break your yolks.

Ham Omelette.—Whisk your eggs very light, and add to it as much grated ham as will flavor it.

Mush Bread.—Make some thin Indian meal, when cool add a little salt and flour enough to make a thick batter.

Egg Bread.—This is made in the same manner as wheat, only it must have more eye flour to make a stiffer dough.

Common Mustard.—One tablespoonful of ground mustard, one teaspoonful of sugar, one teaspoonful of salt.

Cherry Vinegar.—Put half a pint of cherry seed into a quart of vinegar; bottle it in a month it will be fit for use.
