An examination was made by Dr. W. C. Bostic who attributed death to a heart attack. Following an investigation by County Coroner Robert Hovis, an inquest was deemed unnecessary.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 o'clock today (Tuesday) morning at the home of his parents near the Poors Ford section. Interment in Sandy Springs Baptist church cemetery.
