AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT THE OPERATION OF THE FIRE TRUCK TO THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF TRYON AND TO PROHIBIT THE SAME FROM RESPONDING TO CALLS OUTSIDE OF THE TOWN LIMITS.

The Commissioners of the Town of Tryon do ordain:

Section 1: That the fire truck for the Town of Tryon shall not be used in responding to calls beyond the City Limits.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall go into effect on the first day of November, 1938, and shall continue in force thereafter.

Section 3: That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
