Duke Power Files For Rate Increase

Duke Power Co. has filed a request for an 11.85 percent retail rate increase in North Carolina. If approved by the N. C. Utilities Commission, it would increase the company's retail operating revenues in the state by \$165.3 million. The increase requested will not show up on bills before October.

The N. C. Utilities Commission approved a 14.99 percent rate increase for Duke Power on Dec. 17th.

The company also has a rate case pending in South Carolina.
