dropped 0.3 percent in price while the cost of replacing a television picture tube is up only 2.8 percent.

Liquid center golf balls have gone up only 3.3 percent since 1967. Portable radios are up 3.4 percent.

Consumers especially worried by inflation can find relief in the price change of ataractics (prescription tranquilizers), up only 5.1 percent.

Bank service charges for checking accounts are up 5.7 percent. Cream or roll-on deodorants are up 7.4 percent. Liquid tonics (non-prescription) have gone up 8.5 percent in price, and canister vacuum cleaners are up 9.4 percent.

Finally, wives and husbands can find solace from statistics that home permanent refills are up only 11.6 percent and the price of whiskey (as of the end of September) is up only 12 percent.

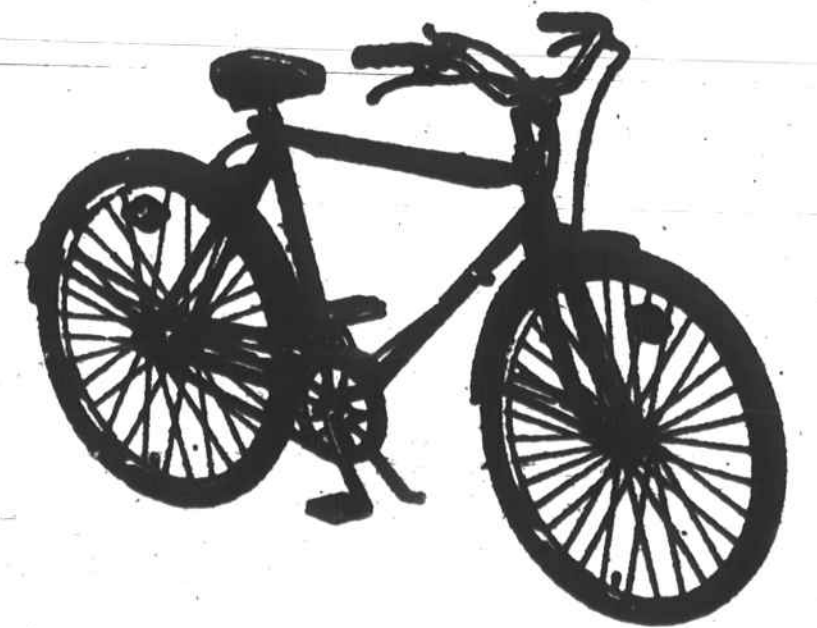
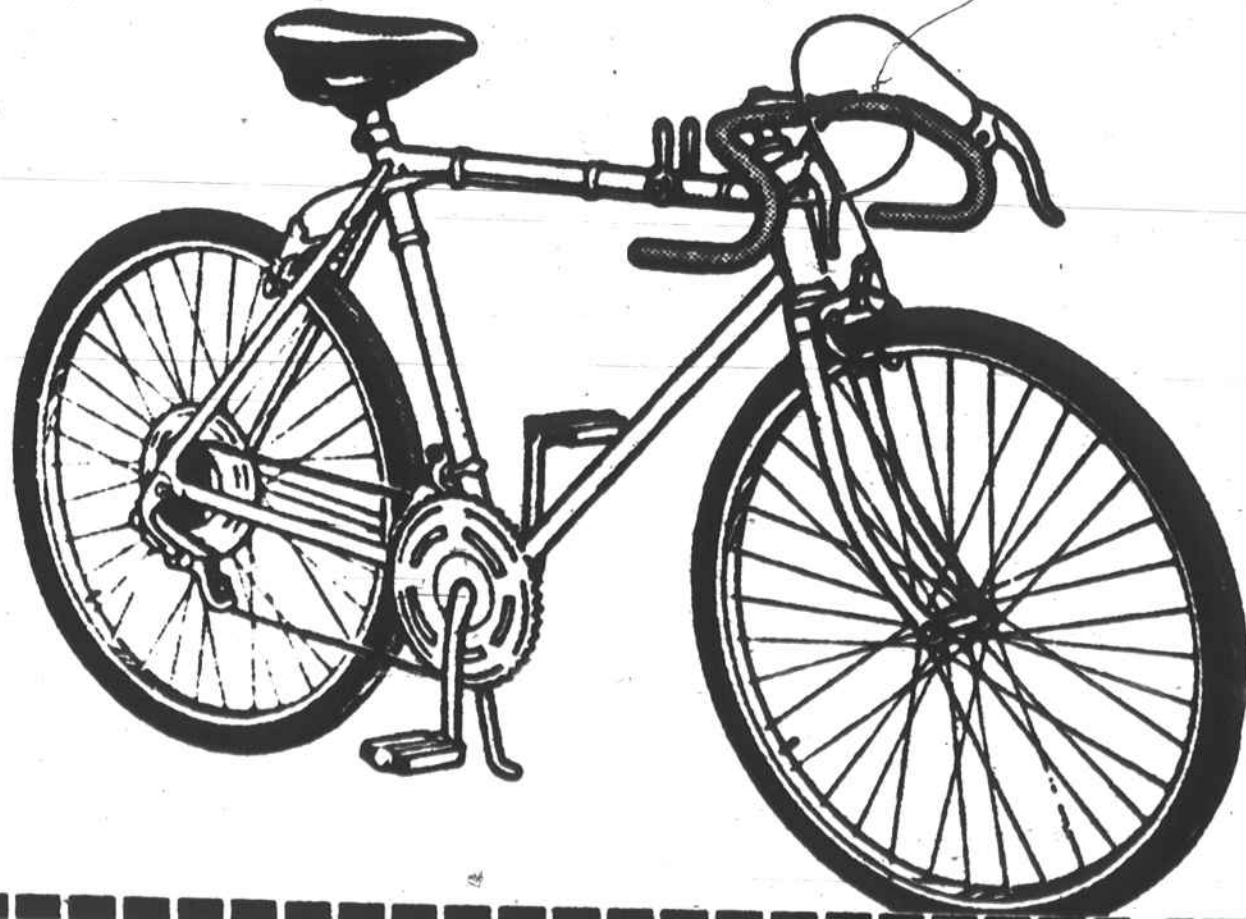
