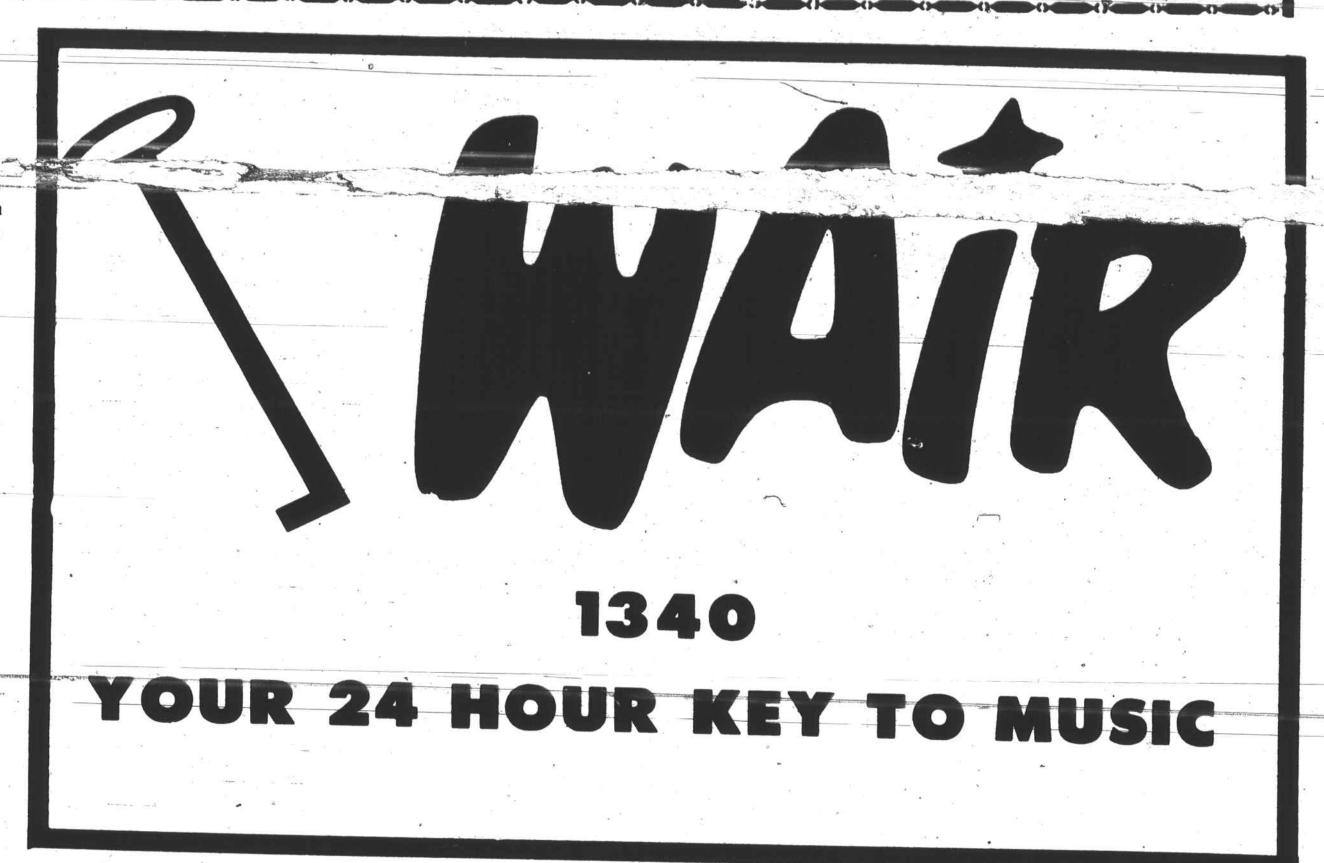
while the cost of replacing a television picture tube is up only 2.8 percent.

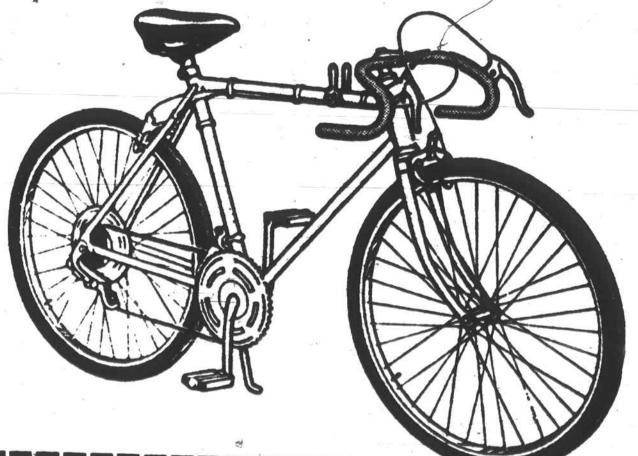

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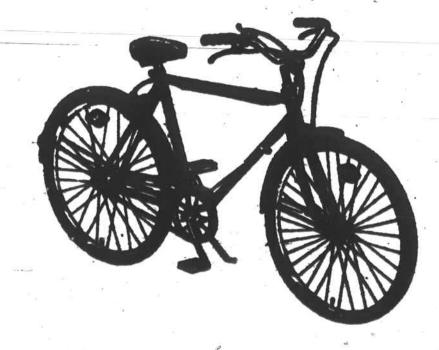
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
