Butler Elected

NTAA President

Dr. J. Ray Butler, pastor of Shiloh Baptist Church, has been elected president of the National Theological Alumni Association of Shaw Divinity School.

His selection, by unanimous vote, came at an alumni association meeting held in conjunction with the pastor's conference at Shaw University last week.

"The ideas that I have to share are in reference to the idea that Shaw needs to be endowed," Dr. Butler stated.

He recommends that the state's pastors and alumni members will designate a church committee or auxiliary group to solicit special gift contributions.

"Such a plan already exists at Shiloh," Dr. Butler noted. "It is conducted by the Women's Auxiliary. They have already recruited eighteen subscribers, pledging \$100 each."

His second recommendation is that pastors affiliated with the General Baptist State Convention be granted the privilege of becoming associate members of the Theological Alumni Association.

Dr. Butler indicated that he would confer soon with the executive committee to ratify those recommendations.

tis than those who eat spicy food. Exactly why this might be true is not clear. But eating horse-radish and hot foods may trigger an overproduction of mucus in the stomach and also in the respiratory system. The outpouring of fluid, which is thin mucus rather than thick, may help clear breathing passages. Before trying spicy remedies, however, lung disease patients should consult their own physicians about the best treatment for their own conditions.

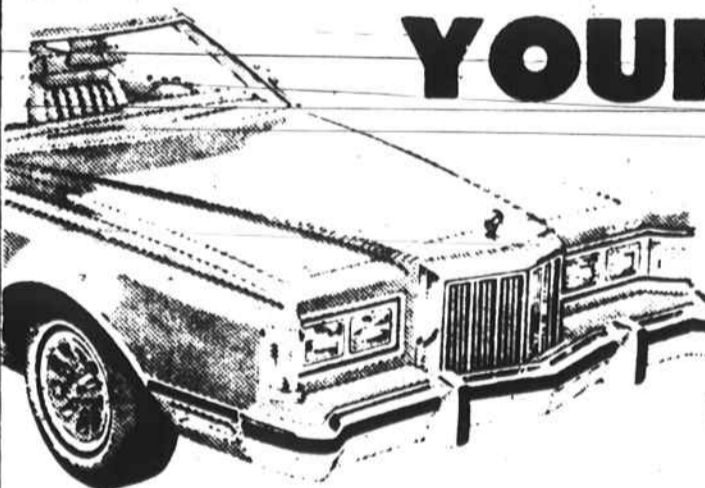

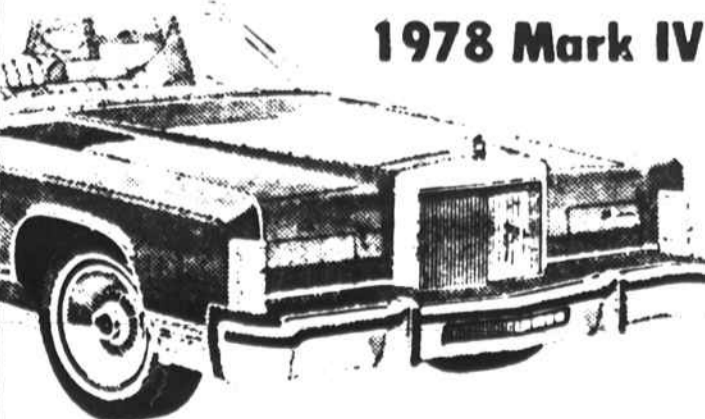

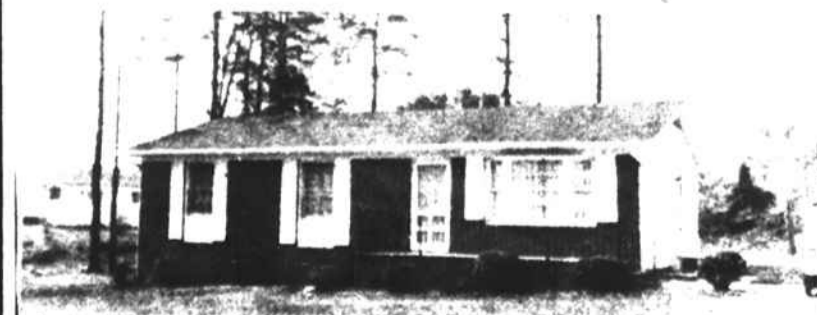
