tis than those who eat spicy food. Exactly why this might be true is not clear. But eating horseradish and hot foods may trigger an overproduction of mucus in the stomach and also in the respiratory system. The outpouring of fluid, which is thin mucus rather than thick, may help clear breathing passages. Before trying spicy remedies, however, lung disease patients should consult their own physicians about the best treatment for their own conditions.


