A highlight of his quarter-century of fighting for blacks to have the right to vote was a 1957 appearance before the Senate Judiciary Committee's Subcommittee on Constitutional Rights. ...ing the hearing was Sen. Gaines was one of five persons inducted into the hall last week. The others were Forrest "Smokey" Burgess, an 18 year Major League veteran, who holds the record for career pinch hits with 145.
