yet. We're just at the point of settlement and we've spent thousands of dollars."

"Yet this case has the potential for affecting the way the military in general deals with the whole issue of employee relations," he added.

Although his region "is probably the most programatically active in the association, Shinhoster still thinks the membership of 85,000 could easily quadruple."

"It's necessary and vital that we get people with various skills involved such as people in health care who could develop a task force to study health care in the black community of Winston Salem," he said.

Shinhoster said the perception that young blacks cannot get along with entrenched NAACP leaders is contrary to his experiences. "A lot depends upon the persuasiveness and approach of the youth. There is a willingness on the part of the old-line NAACP leaders to take the younger people under their wing so they can get the benefit of their experiences and wisdom."

The regional director frames his task simply. "Somehow we're going to have to convince people that the NAACP is worthy of their support."

Put Food Safety First

During the summer months, lifestyles can become more relaxed. But there's one area of daily living that no one can afford to take casually - food safety. In fact, during the summer season, food safety becomes all the more important for foods outdoors and warm weather represent potential danger.

The primary rule to remember when handling any food is to keep hot foods hot and cold foods cold, advises the National Live Stock and Meat Board. Hot foods should be held at temperatures above 140 degrees. Temperatures between 140 degrees and 40 degrees represent the danger zone for bacterial growth and perishable foods should not be allowed to remain at these temperatures for any length of time. Special care should be taken with meats, poultry, dairy products, eggs and mayonnaise.

If you enjoy lamb prepared by conventional methods, but have never tried it cooked over the coals outdoors, you've been missing an excep-

tional taste treat. Any lamb that can be broiled indoors, can be successfully cooked on the grill, according to the National Live Stock and Meat Board.
