"The program is intended to broaden their awareness," he said. "Most of them (parolees) feel that the prison conditions were worse than what the thought. "The aim is to get them to realize that 'I don't want to be there, but I could see how I could be there,'" he said.
Martin said that some of the earlier programs where scare tactics were used were found not to be as effective and sometimes had adverse psychological effects.
