A native of Brooklyn, N.Y., Elijah is married to Tom Elijah, president of the Winston-Salem Urban League. They have three children. She graduated from the City University of New York with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

She is a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Top Ladies of Distinction, National Association of University Women and the Flonnie Anderson Theatrical Association. She is a member of Goler Metropolitan Church where she serves on the Alter Guild.
