Before becoming Charlotte's first black mayor, Gantt served as a Charlotte city council member for 10 years and mayor pro-tem for three years. He is a member of the board of trustees of Friendship Baptist Church and Sacred Heart College and has served as a visiting committee member at Davidson College, the MIT School of Drafting and Planning, chairman of the Johnson C. Smith United Negro College Fund Drive, boardmember of the Afro American Cultural Center boardmember of the Charlotte Chamber of Commerce, co-chairman of the National Conference of Christians and Jews, boardmember of
