

# Scouting has a place in the church's ministry

The charter and bylaws of the Boy Scouts of America states that no young person "can grow into the best kind of citizen without recognizing his obligation to God. In line with this basic premise, scouting uniquely has crafted its program and educational philosophy to imbue a reverence toward God, the 12th point of the scout law.

Furthermore, scouting requires that each registered leader subscribe to a statement of religious principle.

The relationship between the Boy Scouts of America and the church may be termed cooperative. Scouting cooperates with the church to offer an appealing, regularly updated program to boys, young men and women, and families. It also provides a wealth of supporting leadership development opportunities, written materials and camping and high adventure facilities. The congre-

gation selects program leaders and tailors program content to meet its youth ministry and community outreach needs. The church, in turn, supplies a natural outlet for the scouting program to grow and flourish.

The broad spectrum of environments and situations in which young people find themselves today calls for variety in the approach to ministry. Even though most congregations provide youth education and social group opportunities, they realize that no single activity can reach

and influence all young people. Scouting offers a broad, activity-oriented program based upon ideals and objectives compatible with those of the church and focused on youthful interests. For some churches in the United States, scouting supplies the ingredients necessary to augment and support their ministries to youth and families.

Scouting operates best when the congregation thoroughly examines scouting's basic ideals and incorporates the program into the rest of its youth ministry efforts. It is important

that the relationship noted above be understood by ministers and that church-selected program leaders be included in overall planning and administrative processes by the congregation's decision-making bodies.

When operated in this manner, scouting places young people in organized groups where they become immersed in a variety of activities under the guidance of Christian leaders approved by the chartered organization. It is this leadership that is vital to the young person's spiritual development.

Scouting's appealing outdoor and skill development opportunities provide a lively opportunity for spiritual development, but it is the guidance and role models provided by Christian leaders that constantly expose young people to the challenge of living out all of the life in terms of the faith in God.

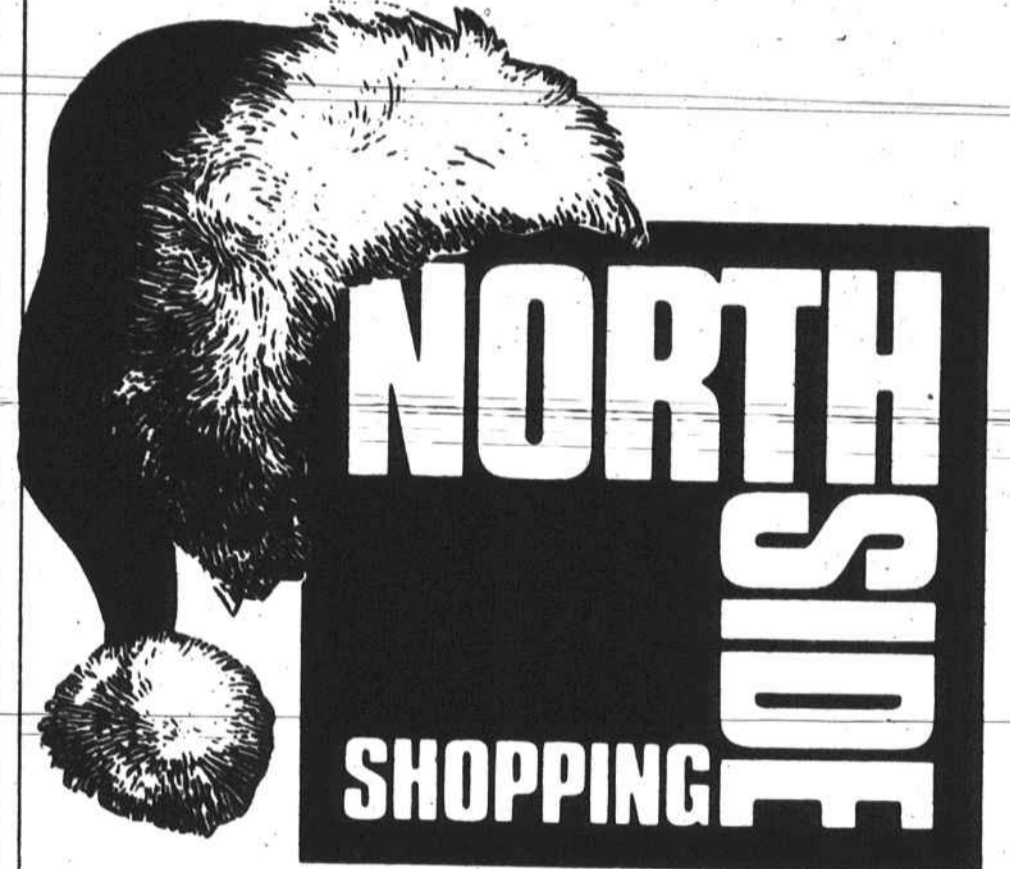
