

Not all signs of discrimination are this obvious. What you may hear is: 'I rented that apartment right 'I'll show you the apartment'

after I see your green card " "I don't really want all the changes...ramp, grab bar... that's too much."

Fair housing is the law. It is illegal to discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, disability, or family status. You can fight housing discrimination and win if you.
