UL begins new family program

The Winston-Salem Urban League has been awarded a grant from Children's Trust Fund for the fiscal year 1992-93 to work with African-American families.

This year 27 projects were funded in three categories --community planning grants, consortium on positive discipline, and support programs for parents.

These projects aim to help prevent child abuse and neglect by focusing on providing support, education or special services families need. In the new side by side program, the Winston-Salem Urban League will work with 30 African-American families to enhance the bonding, emotional ties, communication skills and parentcoping skills to strengthen the family systems. These families will be organized into support systems, including extended families. Weekly meetings will be held to introduce these individuals to culturally-specific parenting styles and stages of development for their children. Human service personnel and volunteers will receive training to increase their awareness of the African-American family from a positive perspective and will be involved in maintaining hands-on working relationships with these families as they work to increase family strength.




