Carolina Was Victorious Over G'boro

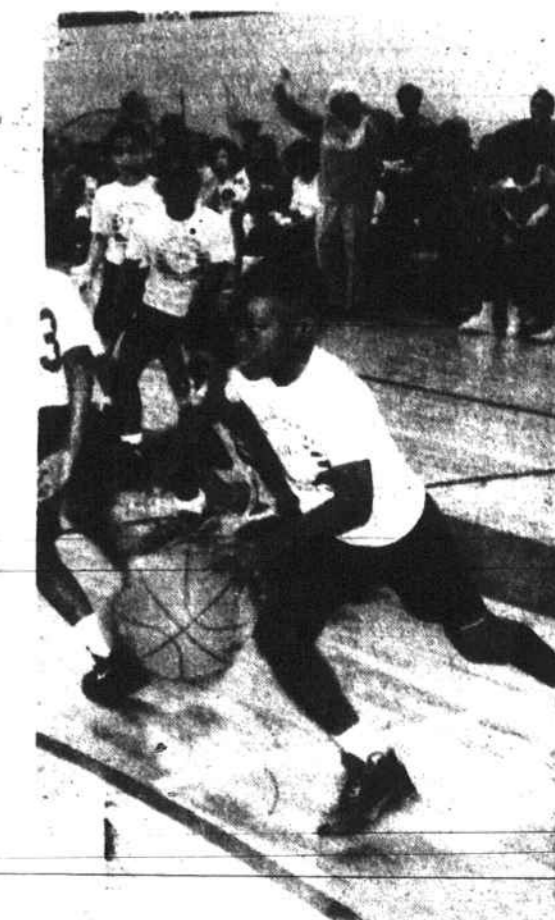
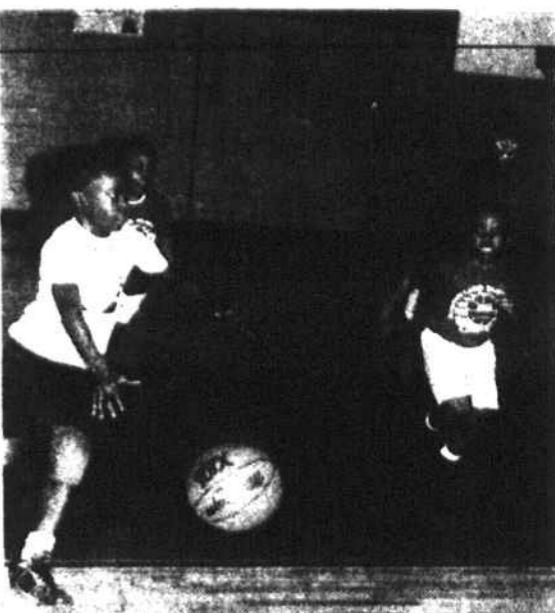
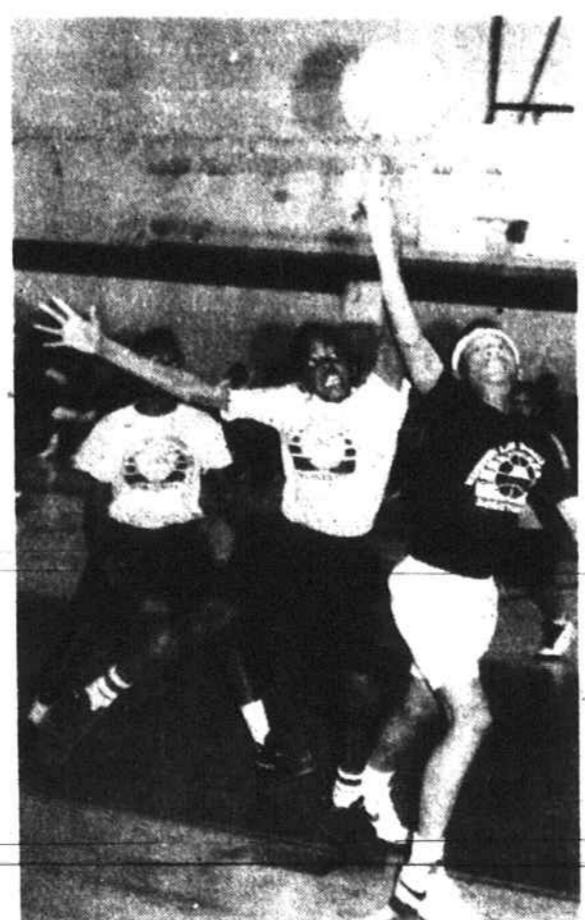
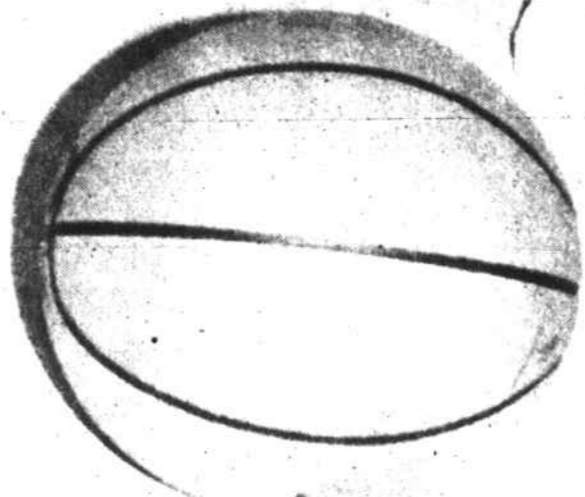
Defeating Greensboro was Carolina, playing on the five to eight year-old team with a score of 42-13.
