Lucas and Bunn sign with A & T basketball

Jeff Capel, North Carolina A&T's new basketball coach, has announced the signing of two players for the 1993-94 season. Larry Lucas and Joe Bunn, both from Eastern North Carolina, are highly regarded players.

Lucas, a 6'3 guard from Rocky Mount, NC led his team to a 19-7

record that ended in the regional finals. At Rocky Mount High School he averaged 24 points, six rebounds and three assists per game during his senior campaign. Selected 1st team All-State, Lucas was the most valuable player in the Big East Conference.

"Larry is a pure shooter, the

best in our conference in a long time," said Reggie Henderson, head coach at Rocky Mount High School.

"He will be a tremendous asset to A&T's program. Coach Capel made an excellent choice in Larry," Henderson said.

Bunn, a product of Northern Nash County High School, is a 2nd team All-State selection from Rocky Mount. The 6'6 forward led his team in scoring and rebounding with 23 points and 10.7 rebounds per game. A Big East All-Confer-

ence selection, the honor roll student led the 21-7 Knights to the second round of the state playoffs, losing at the buzzer to Fayetteville's Southview, who went on to win the state championship.

"Joe is the most dedicated, hard-working young man that I have ever had the opportunity to coach," says David Dewey, Northern Nash assistant coach. "I think he will fit in very well into the A&T Program."
