The event also featured the performance of the Mt. Zion Chancel Choir. The Forsyth County Bar Association covered the cost of the luncheon.

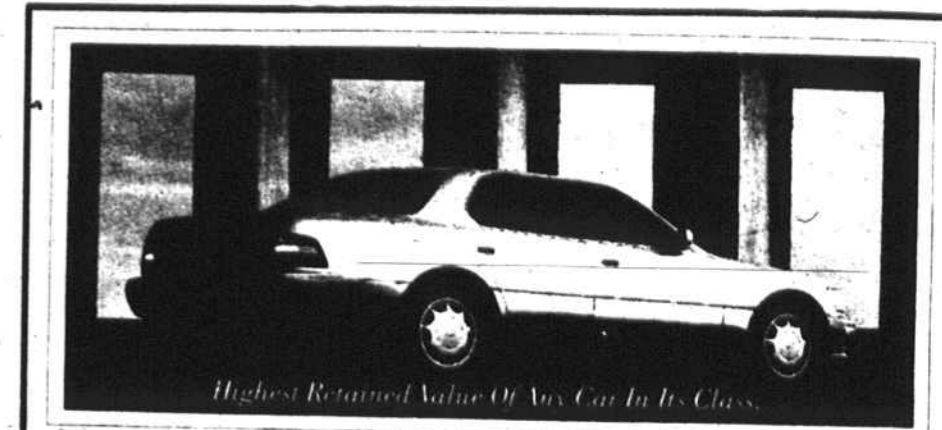


Rev. Ginny Britt delivers speech at last week's luncheon for volunteers held at Mt. Zion Baptist Church.
