Bennett has been fighting since he was 5 years old, almost 20 years, he said.

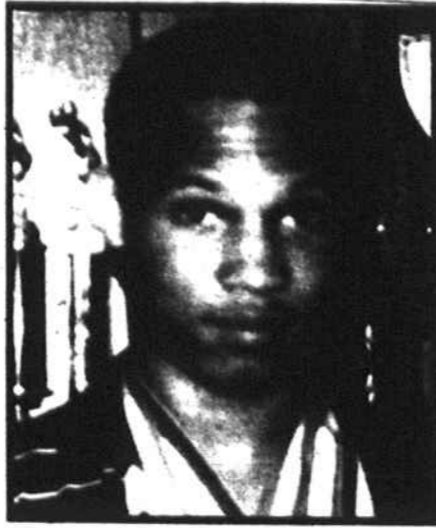
He has had at least 200 fights

## 3-Pointer and Dunking Contest Held

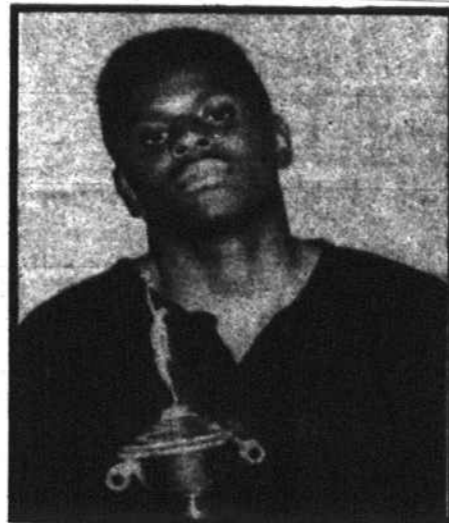
The 14th Street Recreation Center held a 3-point shoot-out in memory of Demond McMillian on June 18.

In the 3-point shoot-out, first place was taken by Wayne Baskin; second place, Tim Skee; and third place Jesse Byrd.

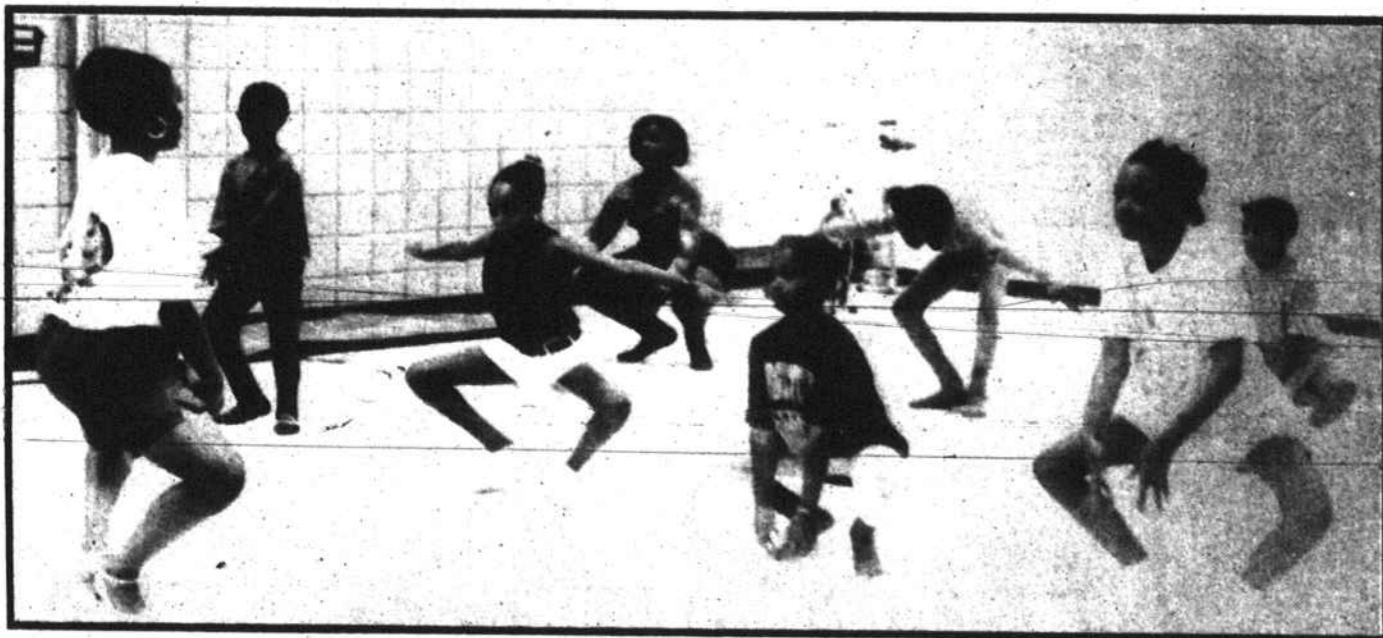
In the dunk contest, Nate Byrd finished first, and Julius Minor took second place.

## Track Team Competes in Championships

Darius Brewington, Marquee Heath and the 15- to 16-year-old intermediate boys' team of the Tri-City Relay Track Club took time out from AAU competition to compete in the National Age Group Championships at Fetzer Field, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

The three-day meet attracted over 2,400 athletes last weekend.

Heath, of the 9- to 10-year-old division, won first place in the long jump with a leap of 12' 3".

Brewington, of the 17- to 18-year-old division, won both the 100

and 200 meter dashes. He was clocked at 10.5 in the 100 and 21.1 in the 200. This is the third time this summer that he has won both events.

The 15- to 16-year-olds also ran well under very stiff competition. Tyron Graham won fourth in the 100 meter with a time of 10.9 seconds and took the silver medal in the 200 meter with a time of 22.37.

Graham teamed with Mylon Hughes, Ringo McKiver, Anthony Little, Jeremy Charles and Freddie Johnson to win second place in the 4 x 100 relay and third in the 4 x

400 relay.

These athletes and the rest of the Tri-City team, totaling 48 athletes, will travel to Raleigh this weekend to compete in the Region III AAU Junior Olympics meet at St. Augustine College.
