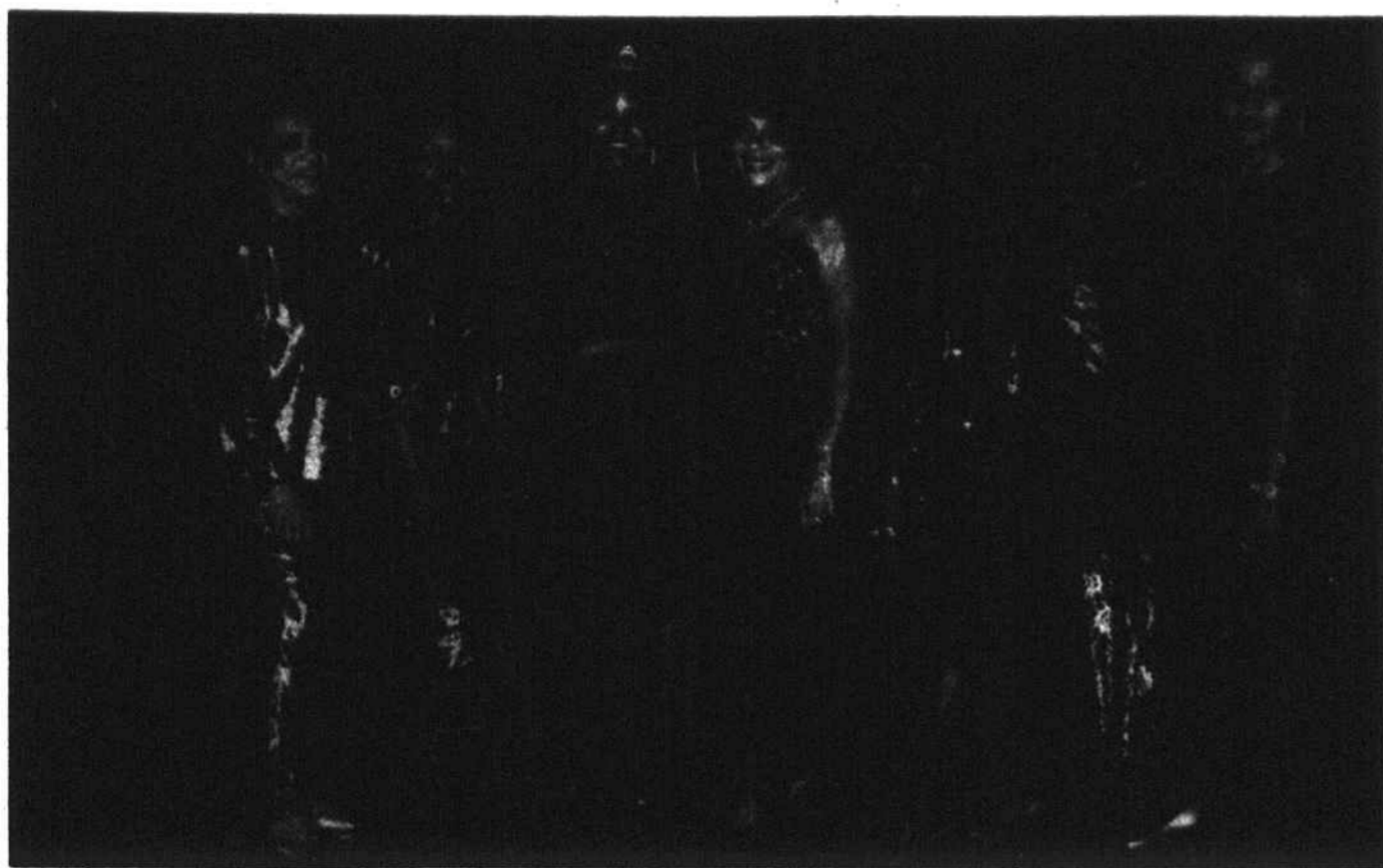


# Ebony Fashion Fair
