A. So many people fail to get on with life because of the feelings you describe. Be assured that you will never forget someone who was so much a part of your life. After a while the good memories grow dearer and the not so good ones fade away. Often we feel guilty to be alive when new opportunities and happiness come our way. This is called "survivor's guilt." This is a normal reaction. And it will pass.
