Cavalcante Wins **Nationals**

Sophomore Roberto Cavalcante won the NCAA Division II National Singles Championship, defeating Rodrigo Urzua of Lander College (S.C.) 6-3,6-4. The team and individual championships were held in Kansas City, Missouri.

Cavalcante, a native of Sao Paulo, Brazil, became the first Pirate to win a national championship in individual competition since Roger de Santis Guedes and Bruce Foxworth teamed up in 1976 to win the national doubles title.

Cavalcante finished the year with an impressive 34-1 record. He suffered his only setback against Oliver Mayo of Virginia Tech in his first match of the season (Feb. 18, 1994).

Going into the national tournament, Cavalcante was the number one ranked singles player in the country.




