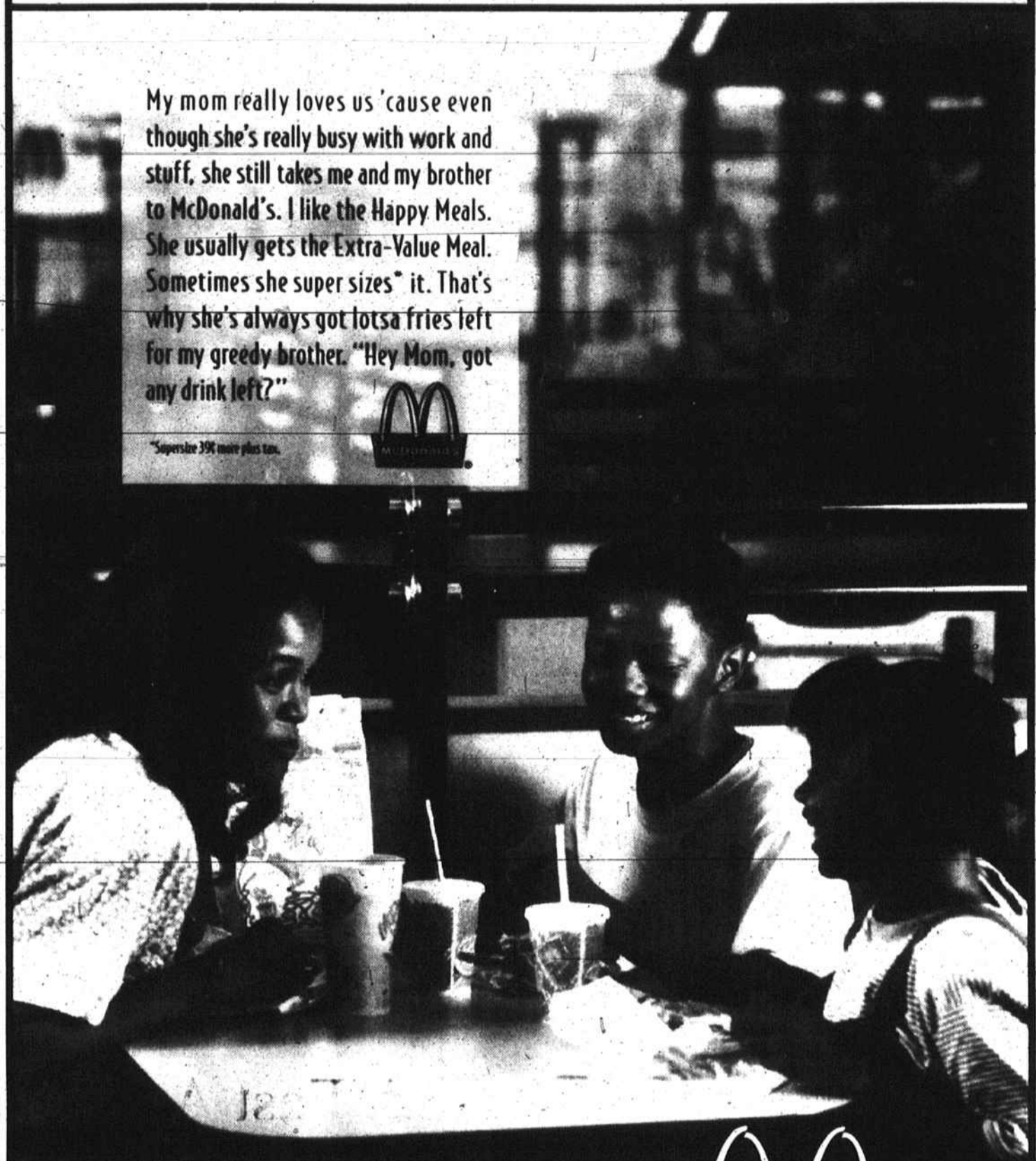
The Tri-City Relays Track Club

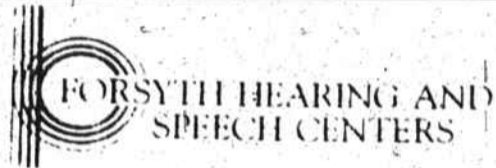
