

Central Sector of Winston-Salem

The City-County Planning Board of Forsyth County and * Winston-Salem recommended for approval to the elected boards on March 11, 1993, the text of the UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCES These new development regulations will create new zoning districts, setbacks, minimum lot sizes, permitted uses, use conditions, and other revised requirements. The Official Zoning Maps for Forsyth County, Winston-Salem, Clemmons, and Kernersville must be changed in conjunction with the text of the new Zoning Ordinance to replace existing zoning districts with ne comparable zoning districts for all property in these jurisdictions. There will be public informational drop-in sessions for Forsyth County, Winston-Salem, Clemmons, and Kernersville by sectors. All property owners as recorded in the Forsyth County tax listings in the Central Sector of Winston-Salem (shaded area on map) have been mailed a Notification of Zoning District Map Conversion Hearings
