Alzheimer's Association Receives Grant

The Piedmont Triad NC Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association announces that it has received from the John Wesley and Anna Hodgen Hanes Foundation a grant of \$5000 to help support its 1994-95 Caregiver Education and Training Program. Students Receive Scholarship

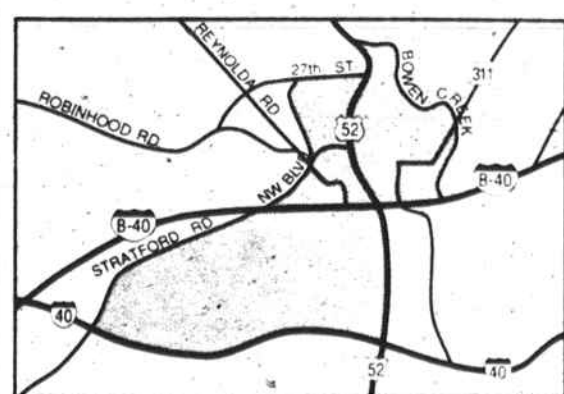

Central Sector of Winston-Salem

The City-County Planning Board of Forsyth County and Winston-Salem recommended for approval to the elected boards on March 11, 1993, the text of the UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCES. These new development regulations will create new zoning districts, setbacks, minimum lot sizes, permitted uses, use conditions, and other revised requirements. The Official Zoning Maps for Forsyth County, Winston-Salem, Clemmons, and Kernersville must be changed in conjunction with the text of the new Zoning Ordinance to replace existing zoning districts with new comparable zoning districts for all property in these jurisdictions. There will be public informational drop-in sessions for Forsyth County, Winston-Salem, Clemmons, and Kernersville by sectors. All property owners as recorded in the Forsyth County tax listings in the Central Sector of Winston-Salem (shaded area on map) have been mailed a Notification of Zoning District Map Conversion Hearings.

MAP POSTING

All the Central Sector maps will be posted at the Forsyth County Headquarters Public Library. Maps north of Business I-40 will be posted at the East Winston Branch Public Library. Maps south of Business I-40 will be posted at the Southside Branch Public Library. Maps will be posted from July 5 - July 25, 1994.

INFORMATIONAL DROP-IN SESSIONS

At these drop-in sessions, all maps of the proposed zoning districts for the Central Sector will be posted for your review. Planning staff will be available to answer questions regarding the map conversion process and the new districts.
