The Twin City Choristers, an all male performing choral group, will perform a concert at Carver High School, located at 3545 Carver School Rd. on Sunday, May 18, at 4 p.m. The concert is sponsored by the Carver High School Alumni Association. Tickets for the event are \$10.

The Choristers were organized in 1957 by Dr. Dunston, who had been urged by Dr. A. L. Cromwell, a prominent Winston-Salem dentist and musician, to pursue her dream of organizing an all male chorus. Cromwell had directed a similar group of men called the Twin City Glee Club in the early 1920's. Following his advice, in September of 1957, Dr. Dunston founded and organized the Twin City Choristers and served as the group's first music director.

The Choristers have performed in churches, schools and concert halls in and around


