Twelve high school seniors received the first-ever Student of Integrity Awards last Thursday during the 2009 Marketplace Ethics Award Luncheon at the Embassy Suites Pavilion.

Presented by the Better Bureau Northwest North Carolina, the awards have traditionally honored companies that go above and beyond in customer service and care. The Student Integrity Awards were added this year. 
