their straw for the bricks and maintain the same daily quota. The Pharaoh will show them who is in charge! Their yoke is heavier, therefore the desert trip is out. There is no time! As the work becomes more burdensome, the Israelite foremen appeal to Pharaoh, but to no avail. Then they go to Moses and Aaron to complain that they have made the situation worse instead of better (verses, 10-21). Feeling their ire, Moses goes to God in prayer seeking answers. He blames God for not doing what He said He would. Notice God's response to Moses' accusations. Instead of reprimanding Moses. God tells him to wait and see what happens

because deliverance is on the way. The stage is set for the showdown to determine who is in charge!!

Application: Do you know who is in charge? Yes. there are levels of authority that we are expected to follow, but as believers do we recognize and share with others the real power. Historically, economically. medically and otherwise, God shows up to exhibit His power above all powers. It doesn't matter if the observers know Him or not! When faced with uncertainty, do like Moses. First pray to God, the ultimate power then wait for His response and finally follow His instructions. First and foremost, we believers are God's representatives here on Earth. Do you act like God is in charge?
