Mt. Sinai to celebrate its 94th anniversary

Mount Sinai Full Gospel Deliverance Center (formerly Glorious Church of God), 2721 Manchester St., will observe its 94th church anniversary and homecoming in conjunction with Founder's Day on Oct. 2 and Oct. 4.

Pastor Myron Dawson of the Kingdom Covenant Church of Greensboro will be the guest speaker on Friday, Oct. 2 at 7:30 p.m. Dr. James Woodson II of St. James Home of Fresh Start Ministries of Greensboro will speak on Sunday, Oct. 4 at 11 a.m. Gospel recording artist Lucinda Moore will be the featured psalmist.

One of the oldest Pentecostal churches in the city, Mount Sinai was organized in 1915 from street meetings and brush arbor revivals under the leadership of the late Bishop Henry Wilson. In June 1976, Bishop John L. Hines assumed the pastorate and ushered the congregation into a new era. His administration emphasized community outreach, programs for youth and seniors, Christian education and excellence in ministerial leadership and discipleship. Bishop Hines passed away in 1995.

His wife, the Rev. Yvonne H. Hines, then became the first female pastor of the church. She has gained the respect of congregants and fellow clergy as an exemplary leader, prolific preacher, teacher and administrator.
