

ADVERTISEMENTS FOR THE YEAR 2009 OR THE FOLLOWING TAXING UNITS: WINSTON-SALEM, RURAL HALL, WALKERTOWN, CLEMMONS, KERNERSVILLE, LEWISVILLE, TOBACCOVILLE AND METHANIA

Under and by virtue of the authority vested in William A. Rodda, the Forsyth County Tax Assessor/Collector, by Section 105-369 of the General Statutes of North Carolina and pursuant to an order of the Board of Commissioners of Forsyth County, dated February 8, 2010, the said Forsyth County Tax Assessor/Collector hereby advertises tax liens for the year 2009 upon the real estate identified below. The amounts advertised will be increased by interest and costs, and the omission of interest and costs from the amounts advertised will not constitute a waiver of the taxing units' claim for those items. A brief description of each parcel of land to which a lien has attached, the name of the person to whom the property is listed for taxes or the name of the record owner as of January 6th, 2010 or subsequent owners and the statement of principal amount of taxes constituting a lien against the parcel are set out below. If these taxes remain unpaid, the lien may be foreclosed by the taxing unit and the property sold subject to the lien to satisfy the taxing units' claim for taxes.

The list of tax liens will be divided for purposes of advertisement in more than one newspaper. The newspapers in which the advertisements will appear are the Winston-Salem Journal, Winston-Salem Chronicle, The Clemmons Courier, The Kernersville News, and the Weekly Independent. The date on which this advertisement will be published is the week of April 5, 2010.
