

Lofty scholarships for local students

Two Winston-Salem/Forsyth County students were among 22 in North Carolina that won corporate-sponsored Merit Scholarships, the National Merit Scholarship Corporation announced last week.

William A. Emken of Reynolds High School received a National Merit Reynolds American Foundation Scholarship. Benjamin Hiller of West Forsyth High School received a National Merit Nationwide Insurance Foundation Scholarship.

Emken and Hiller were part of a group of about 1,000 students who won corporate-sponsored scholarships that are financed by about 200 corporations, company foundations and other business organizations.

Students were selected from students who advanced to the Finalist level in the National Merit Scholarship competition and met criteria of their scholarship sponsors. Corporate sponsors provide National Merit Scholarships for Finalists who are children of their employees, who are residents of communities the company serves, or who plan to pursue college majors or careers the sponsor wishes to encourage.
