THE CHRONICLE NEEDS YOUR HELP choosing the next recipients of our Community Service Awards.

The public is asked to nominate local people for one of several awards by using the nomination form below. **Nominations can also be submitted through letters and emails but not phone calls.** Letters and emails should give the **nominee's name** and **contact information** as well as factors that make the nominee worthy of being honored. The Community Service Awards program, now in its 30th year, honors individuals in the following categories: **Man of the Year, Woman of the Year, Community Service, Minority Business, Lifetime Achievement, Human Relations and Community Organizations.**

Judging for the Man and Woman of the Year awards will consider individuals who have demonstrated outstanding character and serve as role models for others. Nominees for this category can be someone who has triumphed over a personal tragedy or someone who has helped others overcome obstacles. Nominees should be people who have been outstanding in their efforts over the last 12 months.

Community Service Award nominees will be judged based on contributions to the community. The individual must have demonstrated a commitment through affiliation with community-service agencies, community institutions, schools, churches, etc. **The Human Relations Award** is given to a person who has done great work to bring people together across racial, social or class lines.

The recipients of the Lifetime Achievement Awards will be longtime stewards in the community. Each recipient of this award will be someone who has, over the years, epitomized what "role model" means. *Nominees should be Piedmont Triad residents.* Recipients will receive a commemorative plaque at the 30th Annual Awards Banquet on March 21st. Winners must be able to attend the banquet.
