



Effective May 1, 2015 the Urban League expands its service delivery by offering Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) eligibility and enrollment services. The National Council on Aging recently announced that the Urban League was awarded a \$25,000.00 grant to enroll seniors sixty (60) and over in SNAP (formerly food stamps). North Carolina was reported among the leading states with food deprivation or hunger. The Urban League responded to this finding by applying for designation as a site to educate the community about the benefits of SNAP and to enroll eligible applicants.
