

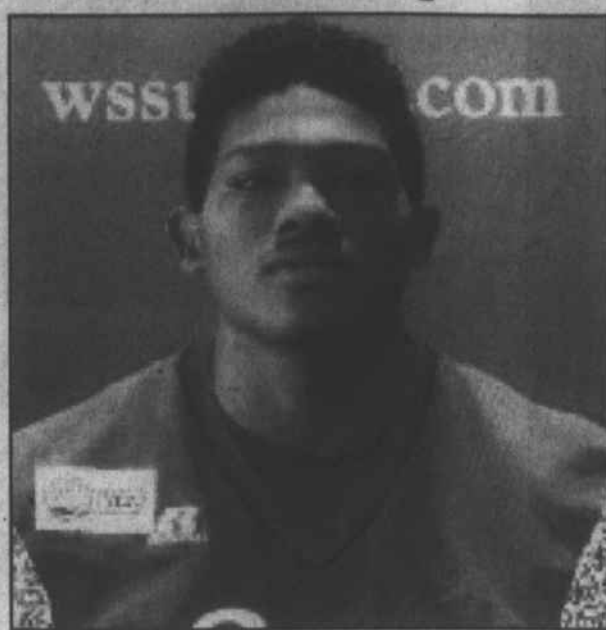
## WSSU's Marcel Caver Jr. invited to Detroit Lions rookie mini-camp

Winston-Salem State University senior wide receiver, Marcel Caver, has been invited to the Detroit Lions rookie mini-camp for a tryout and opportunity to sign a rookie deal.

The 6-2, 185-lb. senior from Bedford heights, Ohio, played two seasons at WSSU after transferring from Youngstown State. Caver led the Rams in catches in 2015, with 36.

During his career at WSSU, Caver played in 20 games and amassed 76 receptions for 1,001 yards and four touchdowns. He was a part of the 2015 CIAA Championship team for the Rams.

The freshman from Burlington earned second team honors after a stellar season.

Snipes wasted little time in making an impact on the Rams softball program. In addition to helping the team claim the 2016 Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) cham-

pion and a bid to the NCAA Division II Atlantic Region 1 Tournament, she also earned a spot on the CIAA All-Rookie team.

For the season, Snipes batted .297 with a team-high 31 runs batted in

(RBI). Her 31 RBIs were the eighth most in the CIAA. She also recorded 10 stolen bases.

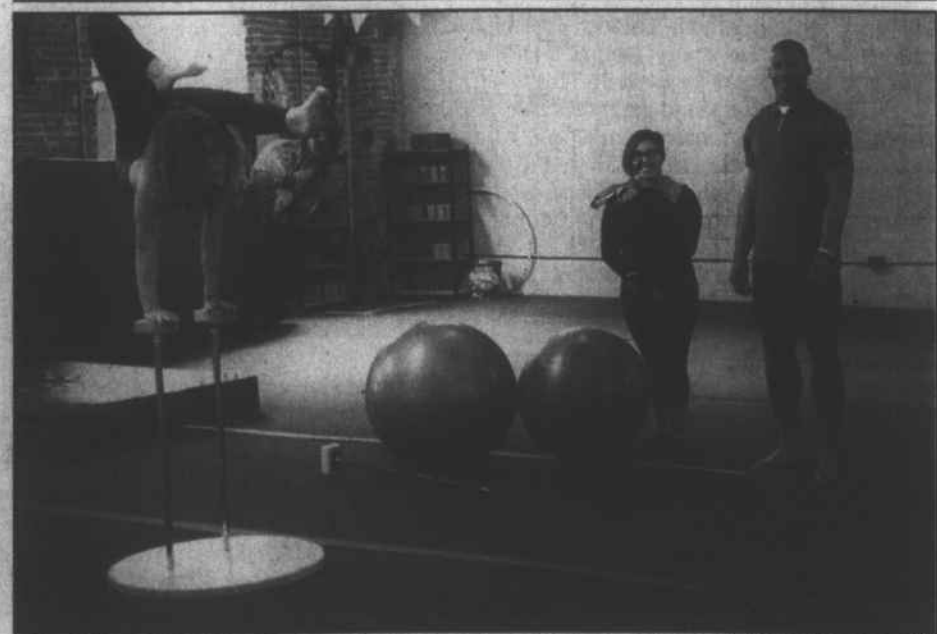
