West Forsyth seeks to unleash wrath in Lash/Chronicle Tournament

Because of the football playoffs the West Forsyth basketball team got off to a late start. They also had the misfortune of having little practice time before tipping off their first game of the year.

The Titans are opening up the season with a game against Southwest Guilford, who were undefeated at the time and fell by two points.
