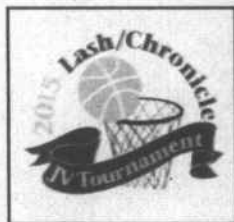
The 2016 David Lash-Chronicle JV basketball tournament started on Saturday, Dec. 10.
