21 Schools On Safety Honor Roll

Twenty-one Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools are included on the latest National School Safety Honor Roll sponsored by the National Safety Council.

Any school may participate in the Honor Roll program. To be eligible the first year, the National Safety Council recommends that schools outline safety policies and initiate student accident reporting systems.

After the first year, a school must upgrade its safety program yearly and submit an annual safety inventory to the National Council.

Through evaluation checklists and other means, each school has guidelines to follow. Be means of a graduated schedule of requirements, each school is encouraged to upgrade its own safety education program.


