The program, made possible by a \$1,000 grant from the Jack and Jill National Foundation, brought together teens from the various junior and senior high schools in the Charlotte area giving them the opportunity to exchange ideas on the many concerns they face in school, at home and in social groups.

## **Social Welfare Grants** Aid Smith Program

The Undergraduate Social Welfare Program of Johnson C. Smith University is a program which is structured to offer students a relevant foundation for the development of effective practice skills for immediate social work employment upon tradhation. Ably guided by C. Dupont Rippy, students in this receive program dividualized instruction in an agency setting, a provision in field practice which enables them to utilize the knowledge gained from their broad study curriculum.

Considered to be one of the fastest growing areas in the entire Smith program, the history of its development is filled with success stories. It was initially funded in 1971 for \$181.00 which paid tuition, fees and a stipend for eight students in field placement and the salary for one new faculty member.

In April of 1973 the North Carolina Internship Officer made a matching grant of approximately \$1,200 to Johnson C. Smith for the purpose of initiating and completing a survey of the elderly in several areas of the Charlotte - Mecklenburg
