Nixon Pardon Raises

Serious Questions

The pardop of Richard Nixon by President Ford raises serious questions, 9th district congressional candidate Milton Short said Monday.

Short criticized Republican Congressman Jim Martin's comment that Nixon "was forced to resign." Short said, "The reality is that Mr. Nixon's own misdeeds made it mandatory that he resign. Sen. Goldwater himself stated that he doubted whether Nixon had 12 votes in the Senate. And yet Jim Martin is now implying that the press and the Democrats hounded Mr. Nixon out of office."






