The 100th Anniversary Dinner was held Monday evening at the Central Branch on Morehead Street with Dr. George Heaton as speaker and Past President Joseph W. Grier, Jr., presiding. In attendance at the dinner were directors, trustees, board and committee members of Central Branch, McCrorey Branch, Johnston Branch, North Mecklenburg Branch, East Mecklenburg Branch, and Camp Thunderbird, along

with volunteer leaders and guests.

A special feature of the occasion was the recognition of W. J. Edwards for seventyfour years of dedicated service to the YMCA as a member, Director, and Trustee.

The YMCA was founded by 23 young men meeting in a room above Wadsworth Livery Stable on North Tryon Street on Sunday afternoon, November 11, 1874. First president was A. Shorter Caldwell.
