Housing Patterns

A series of public meetings to discuss housing patterns in local neighborhoods will be held by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Community Relations Committee (CRC) during the next four weeks. The theme of the series will be "What's Happening With Housing in Your Neighborhood." A meeting will be held in each of Charlotte's seven election districts.

The purpose of the meetings is to promote equal opportunity in housing and to support the efforts of groups which are seeking and succeeding in developing neighborhoods without rapid turnover and "white flight."

CRC will conduct the series with the support of local neighborhood groups. Each meeting will provide information on population trends, housing patterns, and the distribution of public housing and other publicly assisted low income housing.

The program will feature brief presentations by representatives of the Charlotte Board of Realtors, local financial institutions, the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Planning Commission, the Community Development Department of City government, and residents of integrated neighborhoods.
