Rodriguez, Hargrove To Appear In Channel 42 Special

Two sensational entertainers, Johnny Rodriguez and Linda Hargrove, will appear on Austin City Limits over Public Broadcast Station's Channel 42 on Saturday, April 1 at 5 p.m.

Johnny Rodriguez's climb to fame began several years ago in Sabinal, Texas when he was arrested for goat rustling. A local ranger heard this aspiring young talent and he was soon hired by Alamo Village, a tourist attraction. While still working at the Village, Tom T. Hall offered him a job in his band.

Since that time, the 25 year old Rodriguez has relished his extraordinary recording success beginning with his hit single in 1972, "Pass Me By (If You Are Only Passing Through)." His first eight albums

made Top Ten and several reach the top spot of number one. His latest album, "Practice Makes Perfect," promises to be as successful as his previous albums.

On Austin City Limits he will sing "Ridin' My Thumb To Mexico," "That's The Way Love Goes," "Just Get Up And Close The Door," and "Hillbilly Heart."

Linda Hargrove, the sensational new talent from Nashville, wrote "Just Get Up and Close The Door" that Johnny Rodriguez recorded. This is

the chart buster that established her as a songwriter. Lynn Anderson recorded another of Ms. Hargrove's compositions, "I've Never Loved Anyone More," that reached the Top Ten. Olivia Newton-

John's "Let It Shine" was also written by this inspiring young talent.

This vigorous talented lady performs as well as she writes. She has recorded four albums since he career began

and has done extensive touring.

Her selections on Austin City Limits will be "Blue Jean Country Queen," "Music Is Your Mistress," and "All Alone In Austin."
