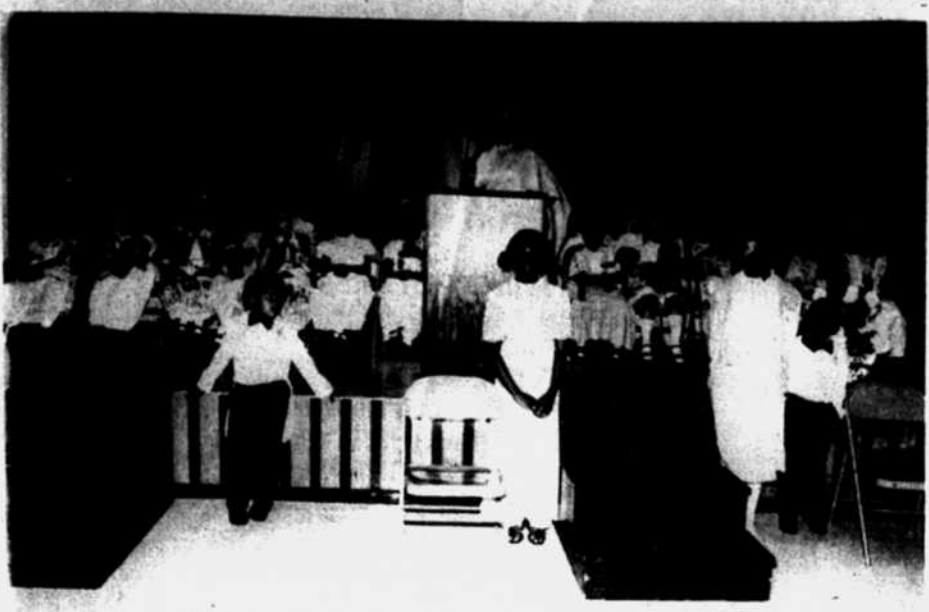


**Charlotte To**
