There are two things you can do to help them fight less. First, realize that they will disagree Therefore, you should not always step in and referee their arguments. Give them some ground rules to follow such as, no hitting. Then let them resolve their own differences as often as possible. Second, try to spend some one-on-one time with each child. Children will compete for parents' attention. Share a chore. Go for a walk together.

In a family where there is more than one child, each child wants to be treated as "number one."

If you interfere less in their conflicts and give some special attention to each child, there may be fewer fights.

Jim Long Proposes Emergency Response Unit

Jim Long, leading Democratic candidate for Insurance Commissioner, this week, proposed that an "Emergency Response Unit" (ERU) be established within the Department of Insurance to assist victims of disasters. Long, who had been campaigning in eastern North Carolina when last week's devastating tornados and storms hit, said he was shocked by the degree of destruction he found when he returned to the area this week.

Long suggested that not only could such a unit be deployed to assist individuals in the aftermath of tornadoes but also after hurricanes, floods, severe crop damage, droughts, and freak accidents like the recent train derailment in Union County and major industrial accidents like three Mile Island.

"We were fortunate that the area was made eligible for federal relief... FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Administration) does a fine job, as do our own state emergency folks. Yet such events do not always result in designation for federal assistance," said Long.

Long noted that, "Most (insurance) companies and adjusters respond superbly during these periods. In addition, proven procedures already exist within FEMA and the Federal Insurance Administration." Long, however, speculated that some additional information assistance, ombudsmen, and backup claims assistance functions may be needed.

Long suggested that the emergency response unit consist of a designated field team, as well as a support unit within the Department, which could be sent to the troubled area within the first 12 to 24 hours to work cooperatively with other state and federal personnel, as well as company representatives, insurance adjusters, claims personnel, etc., to assure prompt, fair, and full response to the needs of individuals during such times of distress and suffering.
