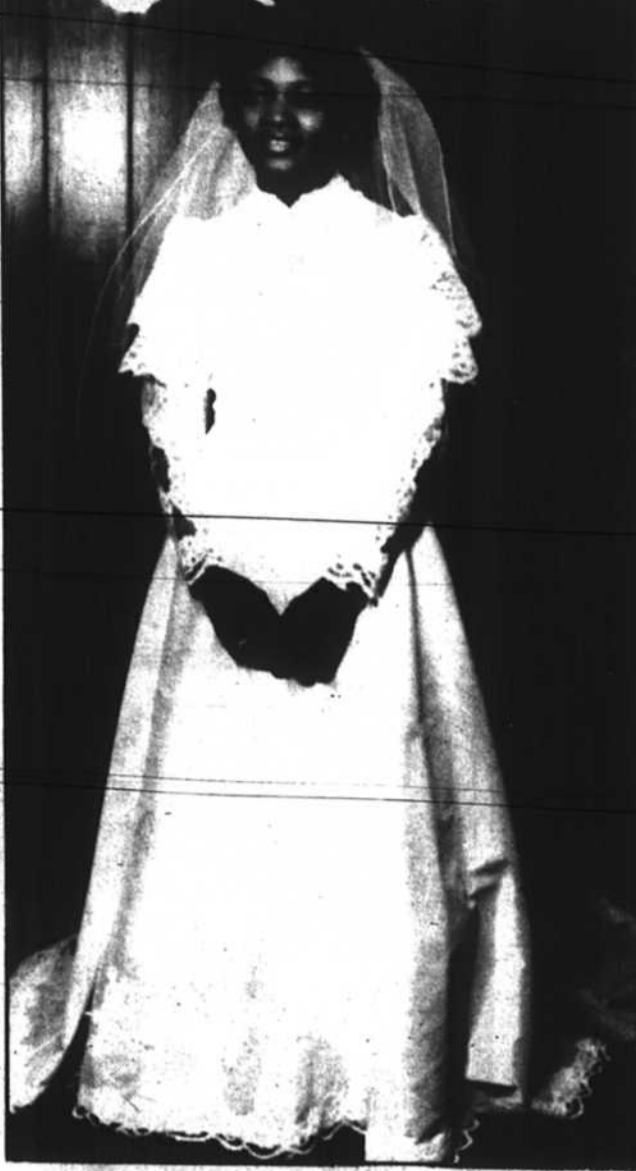


Buford-Webber Vows Said
